Specialty liaison duties may include but are not limited to:*

- assisting NSFRC show secretary with in-person, at-show check in & fee collection, ear number changes, recording judge & host club payouts for NSFRC records, etc.
- handling control sheets for the show (NSFRC will print, you are responsible for making sure they are filled out properly by the writer for the show, and that they are returned to the NSFRC show secretary in a timely manner)

- obtaining (NSFRC will ship to you) and handing out awards
- taking photos for NSFRC newsletter
- communicating & coordinating with host club Superintendent
- any other duties that will assist in the successful running of the SF Specialty
