

National Silver Fox Rabbit Club

Youth Scholarship Eligibility

1. The applicant must have been a member of the American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) and the National Silver Fox Rabbit Club (NSFRC) for at least three (3) years prior to submitting an application for this scholarship.
2. The applicant has been accepted to a college or university or trade school of his/her choice.
3. There will be up to one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) available for scholarships per year. The scholarships may be awarded to one or two applicants, depending on eligibility. The amount of the scholarship to the recipient(s) will be determined by the number of scholarships awarded.
4. Applicants applying for this scholarship may do so as a senior in high school. Applicants may receive this award one (1) time. Applicants not awarded the scholarship may reapply each year up to and including their final year of higher education.
5. The scholarship will be awarded at the NSFRC general membership meeting at the ARBA Convention and Show each fall.
6. Applicant shall be selected on the following criteria:
 - A. Leadership
 - B. Ability of the applicant to complete the course (GPA, etc.)
 - C. Letter of recommendation for school principal or guidance counselor or a community leader, if the applicant is homeschooled.
 - D. Needs of the applicant
7. Students applying for the scholarship will apply with the following form approved by the National Silver Fox Rabbit Club. Applicants should include a completed high school or college transcript. Homeschooled applicants should submit SAT or ACT scores.
8. Applications shall be held in strict confidence. This shall be the responsibility of the NSFRC Scholarship Committee.
