- 1) The applicant must have been a member of the American Rabbit Breeders Club (ARBA) and National Silver Fox Rabbit Breeders Club (NSFRC) for 2 years prior to submitting an application For this scholarship
- 2) Applicant has been accepted to a college, university, trade school or continuing education Program of his/her choice
- 3) There will be up to one thousand dollars (\$1000) awarded per year. The scholarship may be Awarded to 1 (one) or 2 (two) applicants depending on eligibility. The amount of scholarship To the recipients will be determined by the number of scholarships awarded
- 4) Applicants applying for this scholarship may do so as a senior in high school or as a freshman In college or other continuing education program. Applicants may receive this award one (1) time Applicants not awarded the scholarship may reapply each year up to and including their senior year of continuing education
- 5) Scholarship(s) will be awarded at the NSFRC general membership meeting at the ARBA convention Each year
- 6) Applicant will be selected on the follow criteria
 - A) Need
 - B) Ability of applicant to complete the course of continuing education
- 7) Students applying for the scholarship will complete the application form approved by the NSFRC Applicants should include a high school/college transcript. SAT or ACT scores may be submitted.
